



In Person Walk FAQ

Q. Is the Walk for Apraxia shirt available for purchase?

A. The official Walk for Apraxia T-shirt is only given as a token of recognition to registered walkers that raise \$50 or more. All registered Apraxia Stars will get their shirts for free!

Q. How do I get my t-shirt and other fundraising incentives?

A. This year, all fundraising incentives, including the official Walk shirt, will be sent directly to participants in the mail. If you raise \$50 by your Walk's deadline, you will receive your shirt in time to wear it proudly on Walk Day! All participants who raise \$50 will be mailed their shirt no matter what, but it might arrive after your scheduled Walk date if you don't meet this fundraising deadline. All additional fundraising incentive prizes will be sent at the end of the year.

Q. I'm not ready to attend an in-person event yet. Can I still be a part of the Walk celebration?

A. Absolutely! Every registered walker has the option to participate as a virtual walker. There will be a Virtual Ceremony that includes all Apraxia Stars and all materials will be mailed, so you have the independence to celebrate whenever, wherever, and however you choose. No need to notify us or make any changes to your registration!

Q. What if I don't live near the Walk location or can't participate on my scheduled Walk date?

A. Totally fine! Every registered walker has the option to participate as a virtual walker which means you can create a totally customized memorable celebration for your Apraxia Star and Walk team. Participating virtually is as simple as it sounds: Register, fundraise, and celebrate from the comfort of your own home! Take a walk around the neighborhood, have a party in your backyard, take advantage of our Celebration Kit, and do whatever else you choose to make sure your Apraxia Star feels celebrated!

Q. What will Walk Day be like?

A. Our in-person Walk events will look just a little different this year. Our focus is on safely celebrating our Apraxia Stars, so we will not have the full array of festival-like activities you might have seen in the past. We will work to follow all applicable safety guidelines on Walk Day to ensure a comfortable, safe experience for all.

Our Walks this year will operate on a rolling model. We will provide suggested arrival times to allow plenty of room to socially distance. Register now and you'll receive all the necessary information to make a plan prior to Walk Day!
